



Managing Coronavirus & Infection Control in the Workplace Plan

Due to the processes currently required to manage the COVID-19 Pandemic in Australia, including procedures necessary to comply with government directives, the following will apply:

1.0 RISK ASSESSMENT:

Personnel contracting this virus is relatively high when the strategies put in place by all States are not followed. However persons who have been tested and declared positive to the virus can be asymptomatic (showing no symptoms but still infectious) enabling the virus to spread to otherwise healthy persons. In order to protect persons participating in our rides, our staff and/or contractors, the following procedure will apply.

If a person:

- has recently returned from overseas
- has a husband, partner, household member who has recently returned from overseas
- has to their knowledge had a recent contact with a person who has the virus

then they should contact their GP, quarantine for 14 days and undertake testing for the virus and must not attend a work site until they receive a negative test.

If a person feels unwell, or has recognised symptoms on the day they are to be tested, then they must not attend the workplace.

2.0 PROACTIVE MEASURES DURING OPERATION OF AMUSEMENTS:

- Chant Amusements staff will undertake regular handwashing, with sanitisers being employed to clean surfaces, including handrails supporting structures/poles and seating on completion of each amusement run.
- Hand sanitiser will be provided for use by staff and participants prior to the ride and on completion.
- The Operator will wear protective gloves to mitigate any risks due to the requirement to check and sometimes adjust protective handrails and barriers.
- Personnel engaging in any ride will be requested to maintain the **1.5 metres** while waiting for their ride, in marked zones. A member of the staff will be required to ensure that personnel are directed in small groups to reduce congestion when accessing rides or leaving rides during the exit process.
- Personnel engaging in any ride must cough into their elbow or use a tissue; sneezing will also require the person to cover their nose and mouth with a tissue which must be disposed of safely in a bin provided.
- A poster will be displayed at the entry point to each ride detailing procedures to be applied during the ride program.
- Household groups will be permitted to ride together dependent on the weight and integrity of the ride, however other participants will be directed to single seating to ensure social distancing can be maintained and the safety and integrity of the ride can be assured. Where the safety of the ride may be compromised, household groups will be asked to take separate seating.



3.0 WORKPLACE MANAGEMENT

If a member of staff has advised Management of a positive test result, then they will be required to follow the latest government requirements for isolation and will not be permitted to attend the work site. Equipment and/or ride associated with this staff member will be closed and a thorough clean will occur.

Ride participants are required at venues to provide name and contact information to the organising group. Where Chants Amusements are the sole provider of the amusements, participants will be required to access a barcode to ensure they can be identified on entry to their amusements.

4.0 WORKPLACE CONSULATION

The Management of Chants Amusements will provide COVID19 information to their staff, together with procedures for the safe operation of rides and management of the public. This will be undertaken prior to site establishment and again prior to the commencement of the program on site.

Information provided to staff will highlight health requirements and the importance of personal hygiene eg thorough washing of hands prior to and after meals, social distancing and the importance of personal hygiene when using public toilets.

The attached Workplace Notice will be displayed outside the entry to each ride and form the basis for monitoring during the site program.

5.0 RIDE ESTABLISHMENT

Access to each ride will be establish with a waiting area marked at 1.5 metre distance per person or household group.

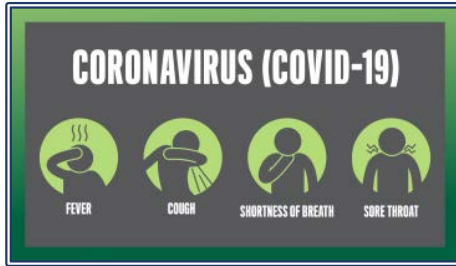
Entry to the ride will be via a zoned access, with exits to occur at a separate marked zone. Where separate entry/exit points cannot be achieved, the entry point will be separated from the exit zone via barrier tape and a staggered entry /exit process will occur.

Persons waiting for a ride must follow the social distancing of 1.5 metres requirement and any person not abiding by this requirement will be requested to conform, however if they refuse they will be asked to leave; operator may request assistance if required, to ensure conformance.

The operator managing the patrons waiting for rides must ensure that all areas are thoroughly cleaned prior to organising staggered groups to enter the ride precinct, to reduce congestion and enable rides to be accessed safely. Persons leaving rides must wait for the instructions by the operator to ensure the exit process is managed safely.

HOW IS CORONAVIRUS SPREAD?

- Close contact with a person who has the disease;
- Droplets spread in the air from someone coughing or sneezing
- Coming into contact with a contaminated surface, e.g. hand rail, door handle etc. and then touching your mouth or face.

HOW CAN YOU PREVENT THE SPREAD?

We can all help to prevent the spread of infection by practicing some very simple techniques:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water – especially before and after eating or going to the toilet; you can also use a hand sanitizer in between washes for additional protection.



- Wet your hands with water
- Apply soap
- Rub hands together, including in between fingers and the back of the hand for at least 20 seconds
- Rinse with water.
- Dry hands thoroughly

- If you need to sneeze or cough; cough into your elbow or use a tissue to cover your mouth and nose and then immediately dispose of the tissue in a bin.
- **Keep your distance – wherever possible maintain a 1.5 metre distance from another person;**
- Minimise physical contact – don't shake hands.



RIDE REQUIREMENTS:

- **If you feel unwell you cannot participate in the ride.**
- Ensure you and/or any household members have registered for the site event;
- Follow all instructions provided by the operator, including entry and exit to ride;
- Try to limit the surfaces that you touch during the ride;
- Use sanitiser provided to clean hands on entry and prior to leaving ride area;
- The Operator will wipe down surfaces and equipment with sanitised wipes on completion of each ride.
